Hosted by The Fralin Museum of Art at UVA Volunteer Board and our J. Sanford Miller Family Director, Karen E. Milbourne, our first *Fralin Excursion* of the 2024-2025 year will be a day trip to Washington, DC!

Travel with us to the **Smithsonian National Museum of African Art** for an exceptional opportunity to tour two award winning exhibitions curated by our director, Karen E. Milbourne. She will lead us through her exhibition, *From the Deep: In the Wake of Drexciya with Ayana V. Jackson* which just won a Smithsonian Exhibition award and her exhibition, *John Akomfrah: Five Murmurations* which was selected as the #13 in the best exhibitions worldwide of 2023 by the art journal, Hyperallergic.

Following our exhibition tours, we will have lunch at Swahili Village – The Consulate, a trendy fine dining African restaurant serving Kenyan classics. Afterwards we will tour the **private collection** at the D.C. home of contemporary art collectors Reuben and Kimberly Charles.
