Writer's Eye 2023 | Competition guidelines

What to submit	Write an original previously unpublished story or poem inspired by one of the Writer's Eye selections posted on The Fralin's website. Prose entries must be 1,000 words or less. Poetry entries must not exceed two standard typewritten pages.
Formatting your entry	Entry must be formatted as a Microsoft Word doc Use 12-point Times New Roman font.
	Prose should be double-spaced, and Poetry is single-spaced.
	Do not type your name on any page of your submission; your name should only appear on the entry form.
	All pages of your word doc or pdf file should include:
	The title of your poem or story.The artist of the artwork that inspired your entry.
	Save the word doc or pdf file as title of your work_artist of artwork.
	Failure to format entries as instructed may disqualify your entry.
Submitting your entry	We will only accept electronic entries this year. You may only submit one entry . Entries must be submitted no later than: 11:59 pm, Friday, November 10, 2023. Entry form:-https://TheFralin.formstack.com/forms/we23entryform
Complete entry form	The entry form is designed for only one person's information to be entered and submitted at a time. An entry form is required for every person that enters. Do not submit one entry form for your entire class.
Upload the file	Confirm your word doc is formatted correctly and is less than 24MB. Click <i>Choose File</i> and select your file. Upload only one person's entry at a time. Teachers, do not upload a word doc file that contains all of your students' entries.
Submit Form	Failure to submit an individual form and file for each student may result in the disqualification of students' entries.
Please note	Authors give permission to The Fralin Museum of Art to publish entries upon submission to this competition. The Fralin reserves the right to eliminate a category if entries are not sufficient in number or quality.
